SOME THOUGHTS TO CONSIDER

Within Freemasonry there are many different paths from which to choose. Many Masons are members of various Appendant Bodies. These include York Rite, Scottish Rite, The Shrine, Order of the Eastern Star, The Grotto, and many more. All of these groups promote fine ideas and principals to expand our knowledge in our journey through this great fraternity. It is, however, important to remember that the beginning the journey for each of us is the Blue Lodge and the commitment we each made as we progressed through the Three Symbolic Degrees of Freemasonry.

I have heard some members say that there just isn't enough time for them to continue to be active in any of the Masonic events at the Lodge due to other duties and responsibilities. There truly are other things that come ahead of the Blue Lodge and Freemasonry. Your family and your job responsibilities should always come first, together with your duty to God and the way you choose to worship. These are learned very early as the most important commitments and should never under any circumstances be neglected.

Many Masons devote considerable time to one or more of the Appendant Bodies of Freemasonry and sometimes seem to neglect or ignore altogether their commitment to their roots in Freemasonry; the Blue Lodge.
